## **SECTION 1 CUT FLOWERS:**

Flowers must have been grown by the Exhibitor.

### **Roses**

1. One stem, H.T. Type Rose Bud, up to 2 petals unfurled or 25% open
2. One stem, H.T. Type Rose. May be wired.
3. One stem or cut of any Floribunda or Polyanthus Rose
4. One stem or cut of any Mini Flora Rose
5. One stem or cut of any English, Heritage or Shrub Rose.
6. Three stems of Roses of one variety, any type, 3 stages of opening, in one vessel.
7. Three stems of different Roses, same stage of opening, in one vessel.
8. Container of mixed Roses, minimum of 5 stems and/or cuts, minimum of 3 different.

### **Gerberas**

9. Gerbera, old-fashioned Single, one.
10. Gerbera, old-fashioned Double, one.
11. Gerbera, Baueri large double, one.
12. Gerbera, any other Hybrid type, one.

14. Container of mixed Gerberas

### **Miscellaneous Flowers**

Dahlias must not have side buds

15. Dahlia, one, any type, under 11cm,
16. Dahlia, one, any type, over 11cm,
17. Container of Annual flowers, 1 kind
18. One cut, Orchid flower.
19. One cut or stem, any bulbous flower not already specified.
20. One cut or stem, any other flower.
21. Three stems or cuts, one kind.
22. Container of mixed flowers.
23. Three cuts of any Coloured Foliage
24. One Cut of Flowering Native shrub
25. One Cut, other Flowering Shrub or Vine.
26. Container of mixed Shrub Flowers

### **Geraniums.**

May be on stem with leaves.

27. Geranium, Bush type, one head.
28. Geranium, Ivy leaf type, one head
29. Regal Pelargonium, one head
30. One cut, Coloured Leaf or Scented

### **HINTS:**

KIND: Rose, Grevillea, Begonia, etc.

VARIETY: Rose Mr Lincoln, red Bauerii Gerbera etc

BLOOM: Flower as in Rose, or group of flowers as in Geranium, Gladiolus, Shrub sprays etc

STEM: One stem with no side buds, foliage allowed

CUT: Side blooms and buds, foliage and branching allowed.

STEM COUNT: as from the top of the vessel. eg one, three
