

Section 1. CUT FLOWERS

Flowers must have been grown by the Exhibitor.

Roses

1. One stem, H.T. Rose Bud, up to 2 petals unfurled or 25% open.
2. One stem, H.T. Rose. May be wired.
3. One stem or cut of any Floribunda or Polyanthus variety.
4. One stem or cut of mini-Rose.
5. One stem or cut of English, Heritage or Shrub Rose.
6. Three stems of Roses of one variety, any type, 3 stages of opening, in one vessel.
7. Three stems of different Roses, same stage of opening, in one vessel.
8. Container of mixed Roses, minimum of 5 stems and/cuts, minimum of 3 different

Gerberas

9. Gerbera, single, one.
10. Gerbera, old-fashioned double, one.
11. Gerbera, Baueri large double, one.
12. Gerbera, any other hybrid type, one.
13. Three Gerberas, distinct.

15. One stem or cut, any Spring Flower

22. Container of any mixed flowers.
23. Three stems or cuts, any coloured foliage.
