- 1. One stem, H.T. Type Rose Bud, up to 2 petals unfurled or 25% open
- 2. One stem, H.T. Type Rose. May be wired.
- 3. One stem or cut of any Floribunda or Polyanthus Rose
- 4.One stem or cut of any Mini Flora Rose
- 5. One stem or cut of any English, Heritage or Shrub Rose.
- 6. Three stems of Roses of one variety, any type, 3 stages of opening, in one vessel.
- 7. Three stems of different Roses, same stage of opening, in one vessel.
- 8. Container of mixed Roses, minimum of 5 stems and/or cuts, minimum of 3 different.
